SERVICE MJ Hassell President's Letter June/July 2009

Dear Zontians:

This is my first letter as your president. I am honored, anxious and hopeful that I can fill this position and maintain the excellence the Columbia Club has created over the years. Before we talk about the year ahead of us, I want to share what you have accomplished this past year.

With regard to membership, two new classifications were added, two orientations were held, two members attended a District Conference and three members attended an Area Meeting. The average attendance at our monthly meetings was 18. Our International service contributions were \$1500 to the International Service Fund, \$2500 to ZISVAW, \$1000 to Amelia Earhart for a total of \$5000 for International Projects. Our local contributions were \$1500 to YWPA Scholarship and \$4207 for local service projects and donations for a total of \$5707. WOW, I am impressed and you should be too because you are the reason for this success!

Last year members provided "Enhancing Your Assets" Seminars to Killingsworth, Women's Shelter and LRADAC Women's Residence. These sessions addressed Women's health, economic and education advancement and interpersonal relationship issues. We were able to provide financial support because of the tremendous effort during the bowling fundraiser that raised \$8165 for international and local service projects. There were other activities, meetings, reports, and newsletters that were handled by you members that took a lot of time out of your already busy schedule.

Now for the New Year! MJ met with the Service committee members this past Monday and already has a slate full of activities and service projects. Our fundraisers will be held September 12<sup>th</sup> and Barbara is ready to take on this major undertaking.

Four members have submitted their resignations. These women were dedicated members of the Zonta Club of Columbia and will be missed. We are a small group but we are a mighty group. We belong to an organization that benefits women around the world, and organization that realizes all women have value, an organization that provides us an opportunity to assist women right here in Columbia and worldwide.

Please join me with a renewed commitment to provide financial and educational support to women worldwide!
